

Summer 2021 Opening Day

WSFAC & Kalona City Outdoor Pool Opening Plan

The safety and wellbeing of our staff and patrons is our #1 priority. Each pool will continue to take extra steps to ensure that the facility is following the necessary measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Admission:

Washington Steele Family Aquatics Center

- Season passes, day passes and punch cards will be available for the 2021 season. However, daily capacity limits of 175 patrons will be in effect to ensure proper social distancing.
- Patrons will be asked to not gather at the entrance of the facility prior to opening and to follow the 6' distancing during the admissions process.
- Every person under the age of 12 will be required to be supervised by an adult 18 or older.

Kalona City Pool

- Season passes, day passes and punch cards will be available for the 2021 season. However, the daily capacity of 100 patrons will be in effect to ensure proper social distancing.
- Patrons will be asked to not gather at the entrance of the facility prior to opening and to follow the 6' distancing during the admissions process.
- Every person under the age of 12 will be required to be supervised by an adult 18 or older.

Safety:

- In addition to our lifeguard and managers on duty each day we have designated a pool monitor to ensure all safety guidelines are being followed on the deck and common areas.
- The staff reserves the right to ask any patron who is not following the guidelines to leave and no refunds will be issued.

Guidelines

- Everyone will be asked to sanitize their hands before entering
- Drinking fountains will be closed, but the concession stands will be open for the summer. No outside food will be permitted.
- Absolutely no glass containers will be permitted in the pool facilities.
- No one under the age of 12 will be permitted without an adult.
- No refunds for season pass, all admission is first come first serve and once the daily capacity is reached we will not admit anyone until someone leaves.
- The last day of the season will be determined at a later date based on the ongoing evaluation of the public health.
- Chairs should be kept 6 feet apart. Families will be permitted to move chairs closer if they choose to, but they will need to be put back and cleaned once they leave.
- All standard pool rules (no running, obey life guards, appropriate swim attire, etc.) continue to apply.

Management reserves the right to modify these guidelines at any time based on the prevailing conditions
