## Kalona Pool Rules

- NO GLASS OF ANY KIND allowed in the facility, including diving masks
- CHILDREN UNDER 12 MUST BE SUPERVISED BY SOMEONE OVER THE AGE OF 14. CHILDREN 5 AND UNDER MUST BE WITHIN ARMS REACH OF PARENT/GUARDIAN
- No strollers or car seats allowed on pool deck
- No outside food or drink allowed. We offer food and drinks at the concessions stand. No coolers
- Anyone 4 and up must pay admission, regardless of intent to swim
- Pass holders need to scan your pass card when you arrive. If you leave, you
  may get a stamp to come back in (unless we are at capacity, then you will not
  be allowed back in until we are below capacity).
- Telephone is NOT for Public Use. You may use the phone when the pool closes early.
- Be sure your child is wearing a swim diaper if needed. Swimmers under 3 and those not potty trained must wear a swim diaper. These are available at the desk. NO DIAPERS IN THE POOL.
- NO RUNNING!!!!!
- Do not hang on the ropes/poles in/around the pool.
- Smoking is prohibited inside the facility.
- Fighting/Foul language or misbehaving will not be tolerated.
- Children under the age of 12 must take a swim test in order to use the
  Diving Boards. Swimmers who pass will be given a wristband. You will only
  need to take/pass the test one time per year (we will write your name down,
  then the swimmer will need to ask for a band the next time they arrive). Swim
  tests will be given during pool checks. You may only try the swim test once
  per day. \*Lifeguards/managers have the right to revoke wristbands.
- Kalona City Pool NOT responsible for lost or stolen items. PROPER SWIM
   ATTIRE IS REQUIRED. No basketball/jean shorts will be allowed. These can
   cause major issues to the filter system.
- NO LARGE FLOATIES, HARD BALLS (footballs, tennis balls, etc.), LARGE WATER GUNS, OR MERMAID FINS. You may have pool noodles, diving rings/sticks, and US coastguard approved lifejackets
- NO BREATH-HOLDING, RIDING ON PEOPLE'S SHOULDERS, OR THROWING OTHERS IN THE POOL
